Thus, student engagement is understood here in a broad sense to refer to students' involvement in citizenship-related and volunteering activities, their political and associative commitment as well as their involvement within their universities and campuses.




The main aims of the project:

- identifying the patterns and factors that support the incorporation of inclusive and active student participation,
- enhancing student competences to allow them fully participate in the inclusive community,
- creating guidelines and recommendations
 concerning organisational structures of European
 higher education institutions (HEIs) in the context of
 the uncertain times and rapid changes.

The idea of the project comes from the belief that higher education institution is more than academic courses and research, and that all of the people who attend and work in this institution should matter and feel motivated to be engaged in the initiatives that are important for them.




The main motivation of this project was to re-establish the sense of belonging to the HEIs community for the students who spent most of their studies in the online mode and are uncertain how the further education will look like.

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■ Study Visit in the Palacky University in order to compare similarities and differences between partners' approach to the topic of student participation




